For the last three years, ERDG's founder Glenn Gauvry, has had the honor to speak to the attendees of the Global Endotoxin Testing Summit hosted by Lonza in Annapolis Maryland, about the role the

pharmaceutical/ biomedical industry can play in the conservation of the world's four horseshoe crabs species, by using endotoxin detection products that are manufactured in a sustainable manner.

On day two of the summit, Lonza and ERDG brought the group to Pickering Beach, Delaware, where they had the opportunity to see thousands of horseshoe crabs spawning along the beach and help those that were stranded up-side-down.... Just flip 'em!™. Afterwards the group had lunch at Sambo's, a local eatery along the Leipsic River, then returned to Annapolis for the remainder of the summit.

This is a wonderful opportunity for ERDG to engage an industry that is reliant upon a test made from the blood of the horseshoe crab to ensure that parenteral drugs and implantable medical devices used by humans and on animals around the world are free of endotoxins.
