Dear Horseshoe Crab Scientists,

I have been most fortunate to be under contract for a new volume of research and considerations in the global efforts to conserve and protect globally the four species of Horseshoe Crabs. Springer, LLC, has approved this book for the inclusion of papers, presentations, workshops and other relevant Horseshoe Crab manuscripts and PowerPoints that may not have been formally published after any of the conferences held in Sasebo, Japan, Bangkok, Thailand and the Providence, RI CERF Conference. In addition, several workshops that were conducted previously in Hong Kong in 2011 and in Sasebo in 2015, their respective summaries will be included in this publication in a special section directed at the purpose of added support and discussion to help support the ongoing process for the IUCN Red Listing of all the Horseshoe Crab species.
